
CASCADE

CASCADE WAS DEVELOPED IN THE UNITED STATES
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) BREEDING
PROGRAM AT OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY AND
RELEASED IN 1972. IT IS CHARACTERIZED BY ITS
DARK GREEN ELONGATED CONE. FOR MANY YEARS,
CASCADE WAS THE DEFINITIVE HOP OF AMERICAN
CRAFT BREWS. IT WAS OBTAINED BY CROSSING
AN ENGLISH FUGGLE WITH A MALE PLANT DERIVED
FROM THE RUSSIAN VARIETY, SEREBRIANKA.
