IT HAS A HIGH ALPHA CONTENT AND IS CURRENTLY ONE OF THE MAIN VARIETIES IN THE GERMAN HALLERTAU REGION, WHERE IT HAS DEVELOPED GOOD AROMA QUALITIES BY ADAPTING TO CLIMATE AND SOIL.</p>

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
