<p>GALENA IS THE ANCIENT ROMAN TERM FOR THE MINERAL GALENITE, WHICH OCCURS IN THE SOILS OF OREGON AND GIVES ITS NAME TO THE HOP VARIETY GROWN THERE. GALENA IS A HIGH ALPHA ACIDS VARIETY DEVELOPED IN THE USDA BREEDING PROGRAM IN IDAHO AND RELEASED AS A VARIETY IN 1978. IT IS CHARACTERIZED BY HIGH ALPHA ACIDS AND A RELATIVELY HIGH CONTENT OF BETA ACIDS.</p>
