DESCRIPTION

CHINOOK WAS DEVELOPED BY THE U.S. BREEDING PROGRAM IN WASHINGTON STATE AND RELEASED IN 1985 AS A HIGH ALPHA VARIETY. THIS CULTIVAR TAKES ITS NAME FROM THE NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBE INDIGENOUS TO THE REGION AROUND WASHINGTON STATE. THE VARIETY HAS A ROBUST SPICY, CITRUS AROMA AND GROWS VIGOROUSLY IN ALL AREAS.
