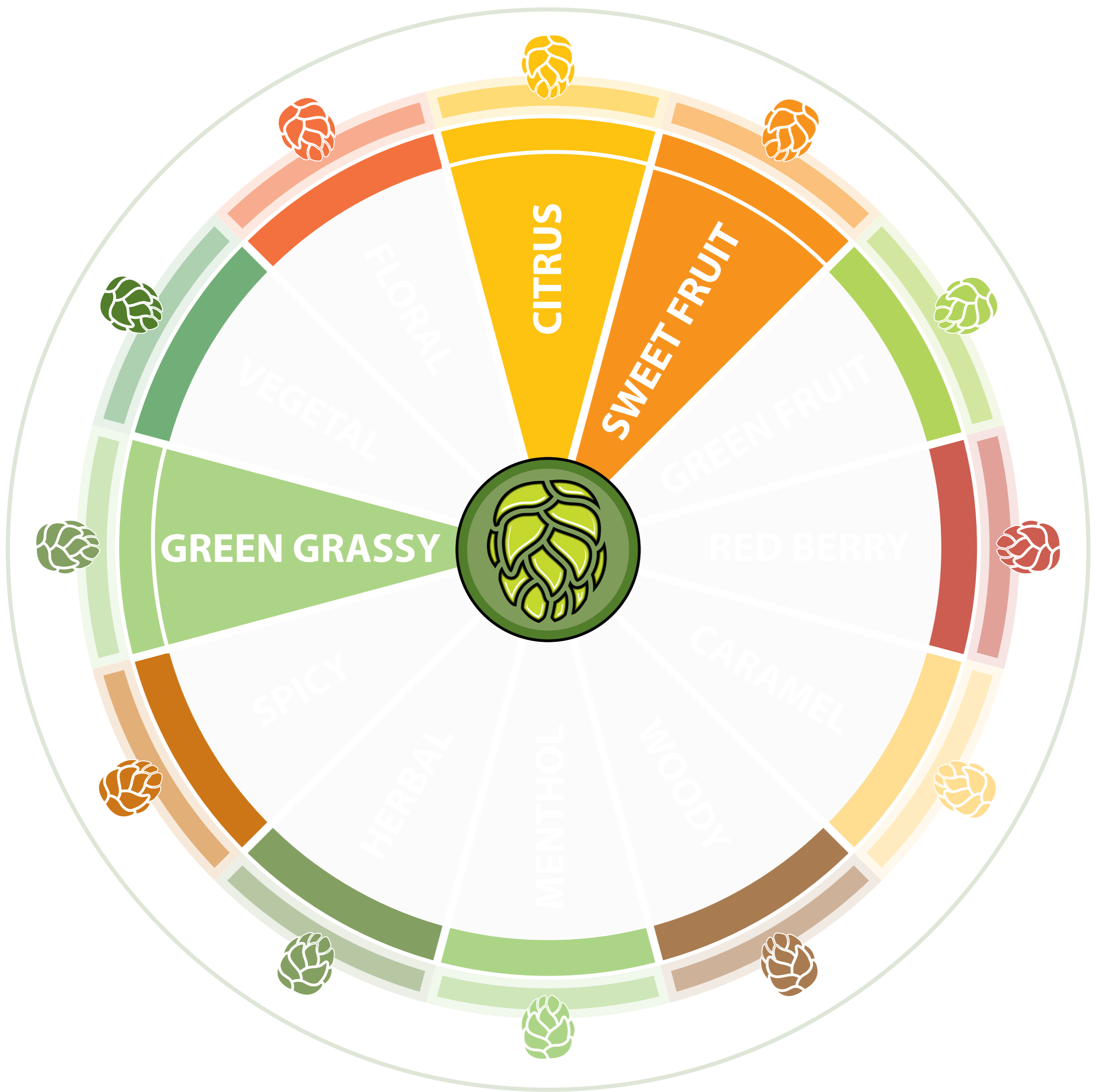


GALENA

THE NAME GALENA IS FROM THE ANCIENT ROMAN TERM FOR THE MINERAL GALENITE WHICH OCCURS IN THE SOILS OF OREGON. GALENA, A DAUGHTER OF BREWERS GOLD, WAS DEVELOPED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) BREEDING PROGRAM IN IDAHO AND RELEASED IN 1978. FLAVORS: GRAPEFRUIT, WHITE PEACH, ALFALFA.
